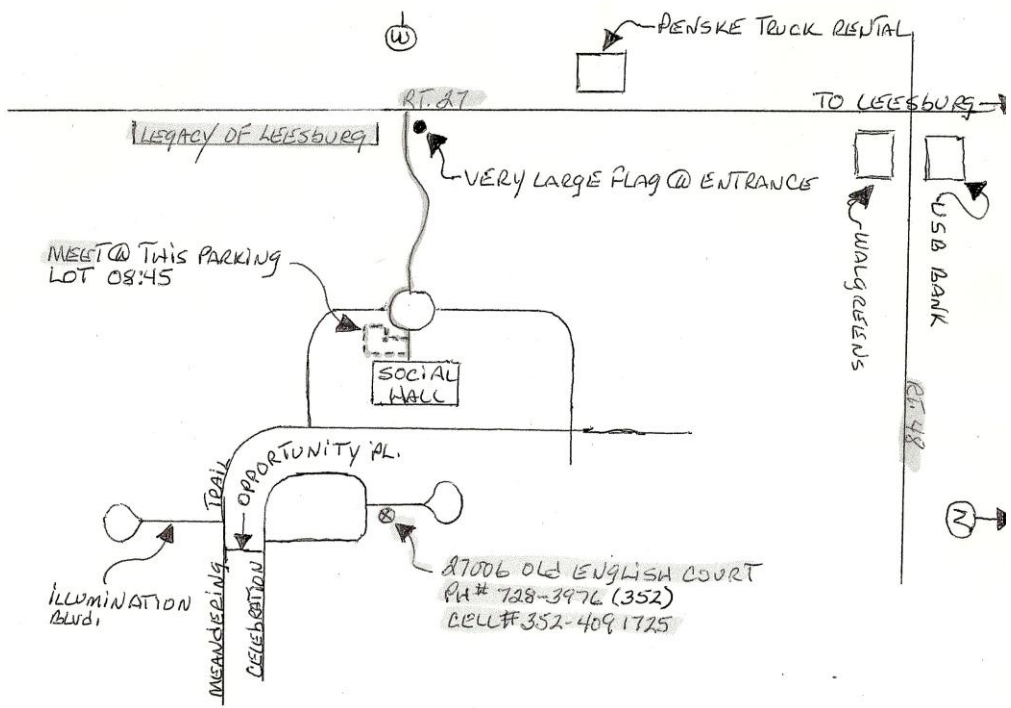
**“What is included in the program?”** There are actually two components, a logbook and access to an on line pilot training course. Sporty's is providing a special “Young Eagles” logbook that pilots can present to their passengers following the Young Eagles flight. The logbook's first entry is designed to record the details of the flight. It also provides an opportunity for the pilot to show the Young Eagle how pilots record their flight time. In addition, the pilot should encourage their Young Eagle to record other aviation experiences in the logbook, such as attending an air show or a Chapter event. It does not need to only record flight time, although the logbook is designed to meet FARs. Along with the logbook is a unique access code a child can use to access Sporty's Complete Pilot Training Course on line. Instructions for registering for the class are also included.”

## UPCOMING...

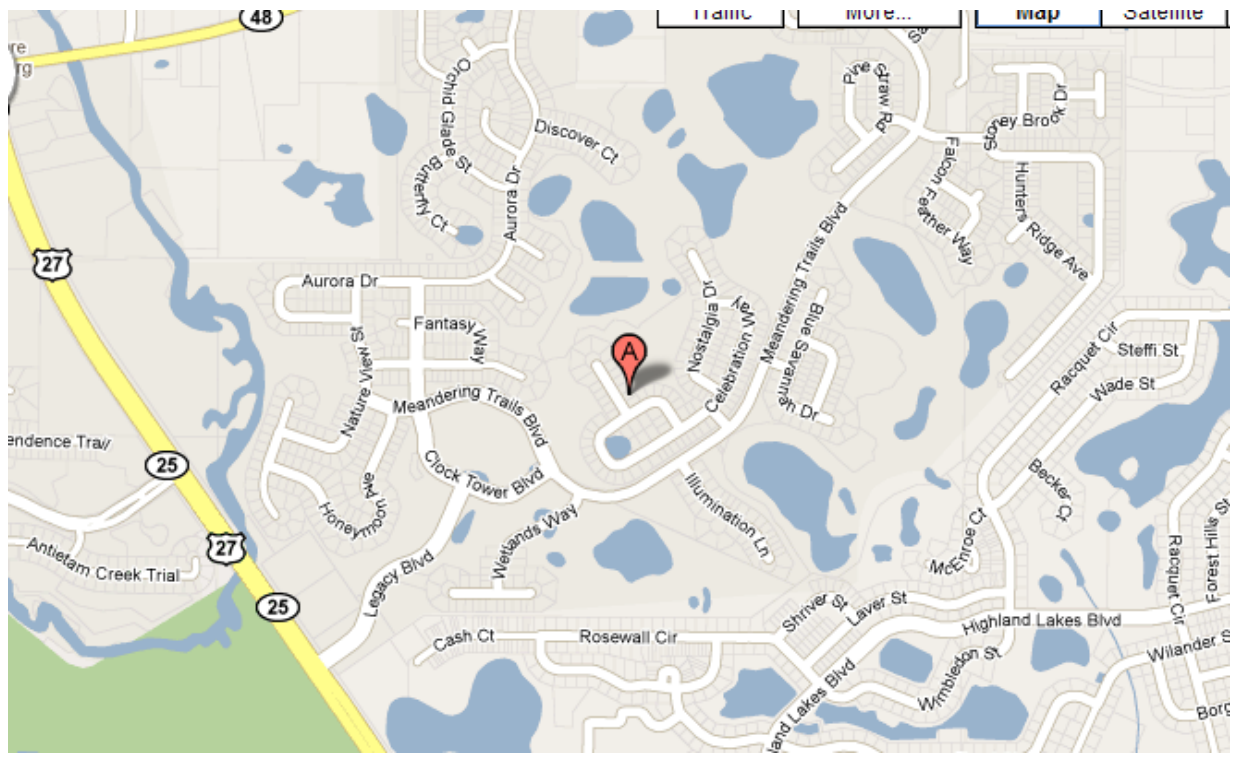

## CHECK IT OUT....

"EAA has released the latest version of its online video player, at [www.eaavideo.org](http://www.eaavideo.org). The updated player contains a number of enhancements designed to improve the user experience:

- **Search:** With over 1,100 EAA videos now online, a built-in search engine makes it much easier to find the video you're looking for. Also, for the first time, EAA's videos are now indexed by major Internet search engines such as Google.
- **Channels:** Videos are now arranged into a series of Channels, so users can browse videos that are grouped into a particular area of interest (such as Homebuilding, Aerobatics, Aviation History, Learning to Fly, etc.)
- **Improved video quality:** The player contains smart technology that will deliver an appropriate video stream according to the bandwidth capabilities of the viewer. So higher definition videos will be delivered to those with fast connections, and lower def for slower connections.
- **Mobile support:** Support for video viewing on mobile devices has been improved, including for viewing on the Apple iPhone, iPod Touch and iPad.
- **Sorting:** Videos can now be sorted along the lines of "Most Recent" and "Most Popular."
- **Social media integration:** Videos can be shared directly to Facebook, and viewed directly in the Facebook activity stream."

## **Tavares Seaplane Base & Marina Offers Fuel Sales, Boat Slips & Shopping**

The City of Tavares Seaplane Base & Marina at Wooton Park in downtown Tavares has been officially certified as an official FAA airport. The Seaplane Base & Marina now provides free itinerant boat docking as well as aviation and marina fuel sales.

### **Fuel Sales**

The Seaplane Base & Marina sells ethanol free 90 octane marine fuel and 100 octane low lead aviation fuel.

### **Slip Rentals**

The Seaplane Base & Marina also offers 40 slips available for monthly rental. The cost per month will be \$6.00 per boat foot length and includes the availability of electric power and water at each slip. No liveaboards or overnight stays on the boats are permitted.
