

President Hargis called the meeting to order at 9:05



**Special awards**-Mateo-EAA National was made aware of his actions last week helping Mark Peebles get his Kitfox back to Mid-Florida. Mateo is getting ready for his solo cross-country this upcoming week.

**Treasurer report**-Mark Banus-Shares-\$262.22 Project fund-\$1796.76, Money Market-\$6,253.52 Checking-\$5,343.50. Report was approved, seconded and passed.

**Activity report**-Paul Adrien absent- 9/28 will be our chapter pancake breakfast. This will need to be reported on social media, such as SocialFlight. Contact will need to be made with Ted Luebbers, as he usually posts this for us. We will need to straighten up the hangar, check the functioning of the griddle and will need to check supplies and get what we need.

**Christmas party**-the annual party at the Adrien's was motioned, seconded and passed. Date and cost to be determined.

**Young Eagles-**our next flight will be 10/19. 11/16-we will be hosting a Boy Scout troop from St. Petersburg. They will be arriving on the 15th and will be camping overnight. The door to the hangar will have to be open to allow them access to the bathroom facilities. One or two volunteers will be needed to meet them that Friday evening to help them set up. 12/21 will be our last flight for the year. Just a reminder that all volunteers must have taken and completed the Youth Protection Program to work with the kids.

**Youth Group/Hangar Report-**The youth group has been active this summer. Many thanks to Mark Banus, who donated a Murphy Rebel project, and Robert Holmes(Arnold's father) who donated his 1964 Cessna 150 to the chapter for this program. Mike Smolen and the kids have been making slow and steady progress with the BD-6. Greg Nilsen has been working on the landing gear for the Aircamper.

**Membership Report**-no changes at this time.

**Old Business-**Ray Aviation Scholarship-EAA National sent out an email that is a game changer on the scholarship. They are now asking that chapters match \$5000 to receive \$5000 on a continued scholarship program. If there are not matching funds, the chapter has to go back to the initial qualification protocol again. It was felt that the size of this funding would possibly cripple some of our other programs-such as rebuilding the engine of the C-150 project. John Weber has already submitted the survey that National sent out on this subject and Gretchen Crecilius, the scholarship coordinator, will also be sending in the survey as well.

**New Business-**November 15th the airport will be hosting the Leesburg High School **SPARK** day. Approximately 30 high school seniors will be coming to the airport to get an understanding of the importance of the airport to the community. Members should meet at 8:30 at the Admin building and then host the youth at the hangar at 9:00. Joel Hargis volunteered to speak and other members are encouraged to attend.


